The State of California is the first and only state in the nation to establish an automated system for tracking firearm owners who might fall into a prohibited status. The Armed and Prohibited Persons System (APPS) came online in 2007 and cross-references firearm owners across the state against criminal history records, mental health records, and restraining orders in order to identify individuals who have been, or will become, prohibited from possessing a firearm subsequent to the legal acquisition or registration of a firearm or assault weapon. In July 2013, twenty-four million dollars (\$24,000,000) was appropriated to the Department of Justice to address the APPS backlog over the next three years. In January 2014, the APPS database included 21,249 prohibited persons associated with 41,842 handguns and 1,990 registered assault weapons. An additional 7,031 persons were added to the database in 2014 due to new firearms prohibitions. Without any action the database would have grown to 28,280 persons. In 2014, 3,922 persons were removed from the database due to warrants being cleared, restraining orders being vacated by a judge, and subjects becoming deceased. The automated filtration of the system would have still kept the system at 24,358 persons. As a result of investigations in 2014, a total of 6,879 prohibited persons were cleared from the APPS database. By December 31, 2014, the APPS database contained 17,479 prohibited persons associated with 34,868 firearms, including long guns, and 1,419 registered assault weapons. The APPS enforcement teams completed the investigation of 7,573 cases, resulting in the seizure of 3,286 firearms (1,378 APPS firearms and 1,908 non-APPS firearms). Other significant seizures included 277,325 rounds of ammunition, 1,888 magazines, 300 high-capacity magazines, 210 destructive devices, and 137 arrests. Additional reports were filed with the respective California District Attorney offices in the event the subject was not present when the firearms, ammunition, and/or magazines were seized"--Executive summary

**Impact on Employment in Cities when the Minimum Wage is Increased**

Paul Jepsen 2017 In 1938 the first minimum wage was imposed (Fair Labor Standards Act) in the United States. It was \$0.25 an hour. It had an immediate impact on low waged workers across the country, particularly African-American women employed in the tobacco industry. Their wages went from earning a piecework rate of about \$0.16 an hour to \$0.25 an hour with their wages reaching \$0.40 an hour by 1945. It was a win-win situation for the tobacco industry and its workers because the industry continued to grow. Theory predicts that employment should decrease if wages are raised higher than the equilibrium wage rate, but the evidence is mixed. Many researchers either show an increase in employment for low wage industries or no change although that is not universal. The Federal government has not raised its minimum wage rate of \$7.25 an hour since 2009. The city of Seattle WA approved a set of minimum wage increases on July 2, vi 2014 beginning in April 2015 at \$9.47 an hour and reaching \$15.00 an hour for employers of over 500 employees in January 2017. This study looks for employment impacts to restaurant workers during the period January 2014 to August 2015 for Seattle and other cities across the country where there was a minimum wage increase as well as for cities where the minimum wage remained at the Federal level. Although Seattle has been the most aggressive in raising its minimum wage, there is no evidence that there was any impact on its employment over the period January 2014 to August 2016, and overall that is also true for the other cities in the study.
